#### News, information and events coming up

#### **Foodbank**

In order to raise awareness of Arden Foodbank it has partnered with three local pubs. Chefs at the Little Lark, the Railway Inn and the Jubilee will compete in August to see which pub can create and cook the best two course meal using the contents of an emergency food parcel.

The competition will take place on Tuesday 20 August at the Jubilee at 6pm, on Wednesday 21 August at the Railway Inn at 7pm, and on Thursday 22 August at the Little Lark at 7pm. In addition to the emergency food parcel, each chef will be able to spend up to £3 to supplement its contents plus three fresh items from Alcester Community Fridge.

The chef's meals will be judged by a panel of four including the chair of Studley Parish Council; 'Aunty Jen'; a director of Masefields Architects, and a member of Studley in Business, who gave the Foodbank the idea for this event.

The cost of the emergency food parcels used each evening is being met by two sponsors of the event, AHC Homes and Chris Osborne @budgetshippingcontainers.
