Harvest Appeal - foodbank

During the summer holidays, in addition to feeding 51 people in Studley during August, the foodbank gave out 367 parcels over the 6 weeks to children in receipt of free school meals in local schools. Thus 3000kg of food went out of our stocks, much of it having been bought. We are already thinking towards Christmas and building up stocks so harvest is an opportunity to say thank you for all the food we have to eat and make a donation to the foodbank at the services. Most needed are: soup, tuna, fruit, pasta, custard, jam, baked beans, vegetables, tomatoes, meat. Unfortunately we cannot accept fresh food or home made jam/chutney as it will be stored until needed.

Donations are also needed anytime. There are donation boxes in Studley and Mappleborough churches, Co-op, Aldi and Spotty pots.
