Advent marks the start of a new church year as we prepare to celebrate Jesus' birth. It's a great time to pray – to thank God for this past year, and pray for growth in the year ahead for our church and for our personal faith journey.

Please consider setting aside **one hour** to help us create a very special 24 hour chain of prayer from 11am Sunday to 11am Monday in the Parish Centre. There will be a wide variety of resources to help you pray. There will always be someone 'on duty' for safety reasons – you won't be in the
